Un-Armed Combat Training Programme

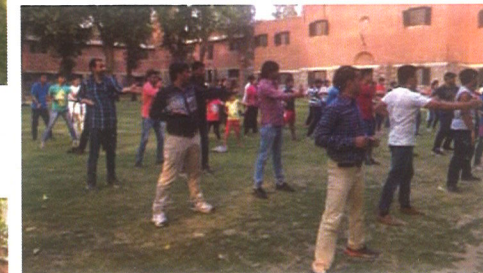
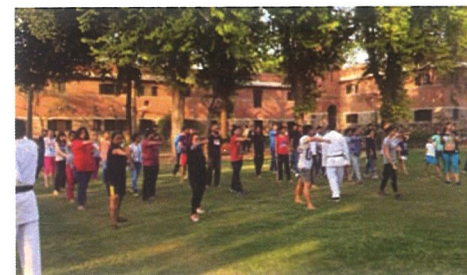
