INTERNATIONAL ACHIEVEMENTS

Sport in college has always had its share of International Stardom. Keeping this tradition of excellence in sports alive are some of the sportspersons who led the charge on the global stage:

OLYMPIAN Ankur Dhama, M.A History (Prev)


Ankur Dhama is an ambassador of the spirit of Stephanian. Ankur graduated from college and is currently a M.A History student. He is a Para-Athlete who overcomes complete blindness, to emerge as National Champion and paves the path for the entire nation with his exploits from the track.

Ankur is an International Track Star who represented India in the Rio Olympics in Brazil from 7th September to 18th September 2016. He etched his name in the history books as he is the first ever Indian Para Athlete to qualify for a track event in Indian Olympic history.

Ankur was slated in the 2nd heat of the 1,500m event in Rio. After covering 50m tragedy struck in the form of a collision when the Danish Smith of Turkey hit his guide runner and two fell down. However Ankur did not give up but finished the race in second place, with a timing of 4:36 mins 19 seconds slower than his personal best 4:17 mins which he set in Sharjah.

At the Asian Games in Incheon, Korea, Ankur bagged 1 Silver medal in the 800m with a timing of 2:09mins and Two Bronze medals in 1,500m (4:23 mins) and 5,000m (16:42mins) respectively. Ankur had also broken the Asian record last year in the 800m.

At the World Grand Prix held in Sharjah, Dubai from 18th December to 21st December 2016, Ankur Dhama struck Gold in 1,500m race with a personal best timing of 4:17mins. He went onto secure a Silver medal in 5,000m race with a timing of 16:31mins. This performance booked Ankur Dhama a place in the coveted World Championships to be held in July in London.

INTERNATIONAL SHOOTER: Shriyanka Sadangi M.A History (H)

Ace shooter **Shriyanka Sadangi** who graduated from the B.A (Prog) last year and is pursuing **M.A History (H)** kept the college banner high with her exploits on the International Shooting Arena. Till date, she has won fifteen international medals for the country.

Shriyanka's continued good form at the 15th Asian Shooting Championship, Kuwait, 2015 where the Indian Team bagged the SILVER in the team event. She was selected for the Asian Airgun Shooting Championship in New Delhi, where her consistency paid off as she secured a SILVER medal in the Individual category.

Shriyanka managed a Bronze medal finish at the Super Cup Event of the 2nd ISSF Junior Cup, Germany.

Shriyanka Sadangi won two Individual Silver Medals at the Intershoot Shooting Competition, Netherlands, 2016.

Currently, she has been selected as part of the Indian squad for Asian Olympic Quota Qualifying Shooting Competition to be held in New Delhi and undergoing training under the National Rifle Association of India.

INTERNATIONAL SHOOTER: Aditi Singh, offhand History (H)

Aditi Singh, offhand History (H) is another junior member of college who donned the Indian colours. She has done the college proud like many of the college Alumni before her as she was selected as the member of the Indian Shooting team for three different events:

- 50m 3 Position Junior Indian Team,
- 50m Prone Junior Indian Team and
- 10m air rifle Junior Indian Team.

Aditi is ranked 4th in the final list of selection for ISSF in Junior World Cup, Suzhou 2015 in 50m Prone event

Siddhant has been a champion swimmer in the University and based on this year's performance Siddhant has earned the shortlisting for Asian age group, World University Games and the Malaysia open later this year.



INTERNATIONAL SHOOTER: Kishat Chopra, 1st B.A (Prog)

The sport in the country is synonymous with St. Stephen's College, as a breeding ground for World Class Trap Shooters. **Kishat Chopra** of 1st B.A (Prog), a Non-Sports Merit Admission student offers the college a fresh lease of life as he revives this age old tradition.

In the 8th International Junior Shotgun Cup organised by ISSF at Orimattila, Finland from 23rd to 29th May, 2016, secured 4th position in the team category and 19th position in the individual category.

In the **Junior World Cup Shotgun** organised by ISSF at Gabala, Azerbaijan from 16th to 23rd September, 2016, secured the 3rd position in the team category and 15th position in the individual category.

INTERNATIONAL SHOOTER: Samarjit Singh, 1st History

A silent, unassuming rookie **Samarjit Singh, 1st History** was placed 5th and 6th respectively in the Selection Trials for the Indian Team held from 25th August, 2016 to 1st September 2016 in Delhi and later again in the Selection Trials held from 10th to 23rd of January, 2017 in Pune. Samarjit thereby earned selection for the National Squad ranked 5th in Free Pistol and 3rd in Air Pistol, Junior Category. Quietly but surely this new kid on the block is earning a reputation of the boy with the Golden Gun.



INTERNATIONAL CRICKETER: Divyansh Singh, 1st Philosophy

Another sport that has a deep rooted tradition in the annals of college history is that of Cricket. **Divyansh Singh** of 1st B.A (Philosophy) has been selected to represent Team India in the U19 Championships Test series against England. U19 Divyansh brings with him a ray of hope for the long era where the college cricketers were considered forgotten at the International stage.



INTERNATIONAL TENNIS TOUR PLAYER: Parth Aggarwal, 1st English

Another young player who has made his mark at the grand center stage of sporting excellence is **Parth Aggarwal** of 1st B.A (English). This new kid on the block is a soft spoken, lean mean killing machine who just does not know when to stop. Apart from playing at the world stage in the Asian Tour he was the fourth Year student who has been selected by the Delhi University as a high performing player from St. Stephen's college in the academic year 2016-17. After joining college in April 2016 he has already a dozen Asian Tour Championships. Twice in Iran and Delhi, Once in Philippines, China, and Finishing Runner up in Bhutan with a prize earning 2500 US Dollar as Amateur Cash Winnings.



Parth Aggarwal from 1st year English Hons took part in the Asian Tennis Tournament in Iran from 7th August 2016. There he lost Pre Quarters to fourth seeded player 2-6, 3-6.

Parth Aggarwal played second Asian Tennis Tournament in Iran and again lost Pre Quarters to second seeded player Moien Mohammadi. His efforts were rewarded by Asian Tennis Federation and he got Prize money of USD 400.

Parth Aggarwal from 1st year English Hons got a great opportunity to represent India in Asian Tennis Tournament in Philippines from 29th August 2016. He

lost to Rana Dheer in Pre Quarters 3-6 1-6 but earned a prize money of USD 400.

Parth Aggarwal from 1st year English Hons got a surprise when he got a wild card entry to Main Draw of International Tennis Tournament in Chennai from 10th September 2016. Although his hopes suffered a serious blow courtesy Delhi's weather caught him with a bad rest due to viral fever he bravely stepped and grabbed the opportunity travelling to Chennai only to succumb to a first round loss to Alex Solanki.

Parth Aggarwal from 1st year English Hons took part in Asian Men's Tennis Tournament held in Bhutan from 16th September 2016. It was a proud moment for him as he was Runners Up there and won a prize money of USD 700.

Parth Aggarwal from 1st year English Hons took part in Asian Men's Tennis Tournament held in Delhi from 21st November 2016. Parth juggled between his University Examinations and reached Quarters winning a prize money of USD 400.

Parth Aggarwal from 1st year English Hons took part in Asian Men's Tennis Tournament in Delhi from 4th December 2016. He lost Pre Quarter round but won Prize money of USD 300.
