3. Remembering Toni Morrison


Event Date: 5th September 2019

8. Self Care and Resistance




Internal Complaints Committee Orientation 28th July, 2018

She discussed the various forms both overt as well as subtle in which sexual harassment can take place and briefly explained the manner in which the Internal Complaints Committee can be of use to a student or any member of the College community who might be facing sexual harassment.

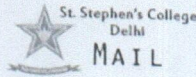

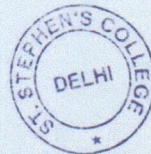
Dear Colleagues,

Stress Management Workshop by Counsellor on 25th January 2018

Report

A workshop for Support Staff on 'Stress management' was organized by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) and Non-Teaching Staff Development Cell (NTSDC) on Thursday, 25 January, 2018 in the AV room, St. Stephen's College. The workshop was conducted by Dr. Malar Jayachander Suresh, Counselling Psychologist of the College. The objective of the workshop was to extend awareness on stress management and to conduct practice session on ways of relaxation. The workshop was attended by more than forty-five participants from the support staff, two of the IQAC members and the Principal, Professor John Varghese who briefly attended the session.

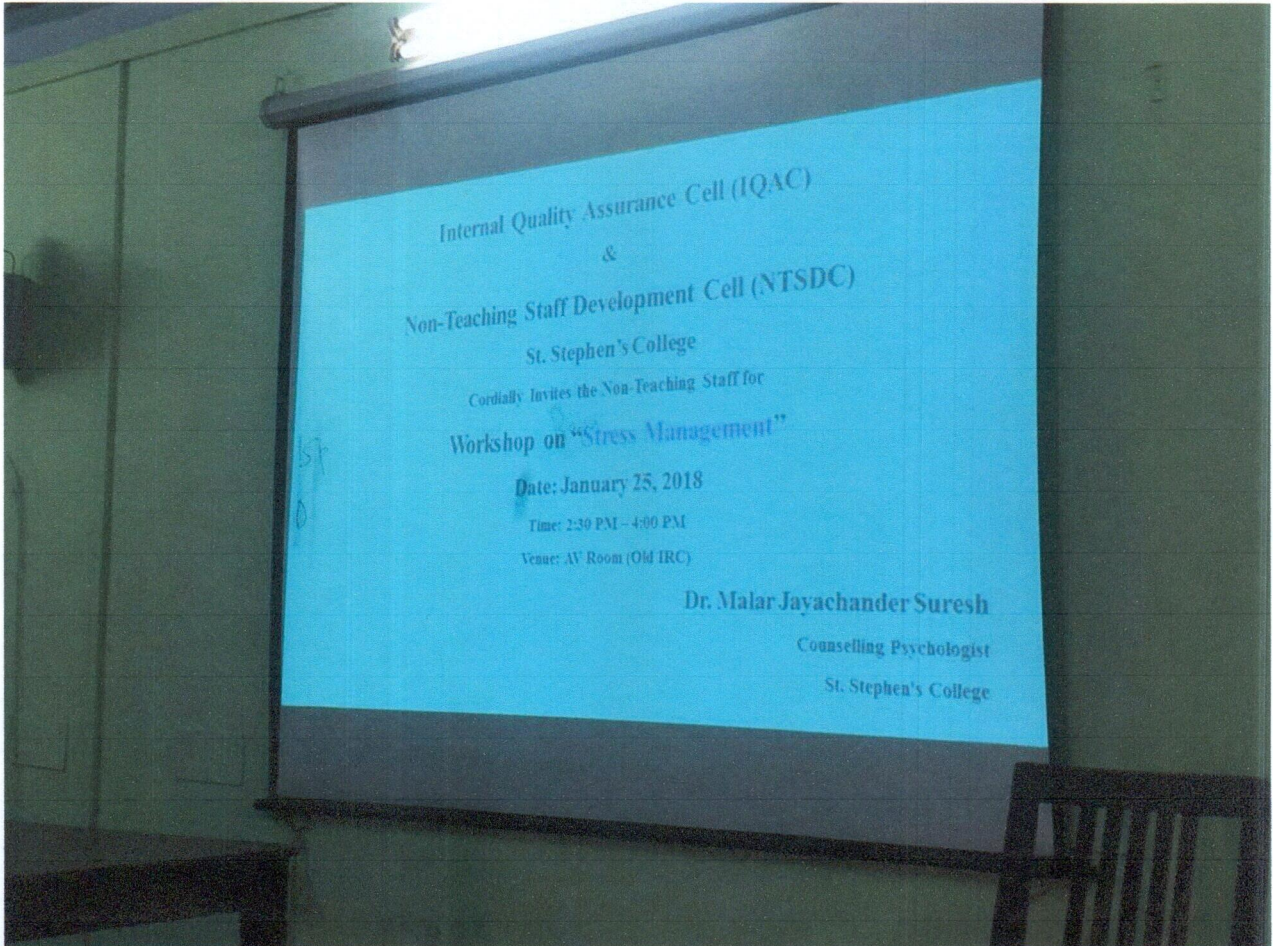
Dr. Malar explained the basic definition of stress, types and sources of stress. The stress feelings and concepts were also introduced. The symptoms of stress and various effects of stress on health were emphasized. Stress occurs when the pressure is greater than the resource. Continuous stress leads to various mental, physical and behavioral symptoms and may lead to depression. The stress management and 'ABC' of stress management in terms of 'Awareness', 'Balance' and 'Control' were explained. The difference between positive and negative stress and the need to convert negative stress into positive stress was explained. During the session, the participants were taught various relaxation techniques and were made to practice. Some key recommendations regarding how to deal with insomnia and get sound sleep is by ensuring stopping usage of all electronic equipment one hour before sleep. The emphasis was primarily on how to live a healthy and happy life.


Overall, the workshop was very informative and effective. All the participants were very happy to be part of the workshop and gained immensely from it. They gave a very positive response towards the end of the workshop and expressed their eagerness to have more of such practice sessions. Many of them have requested for sessions on stress management, relaxation sessions, yoga & meditation, sports activities, singing or other stage programmes. 








Medical Facility during COVID (COVID Isolation Room)






2. Female Guard in front of Rudra North block



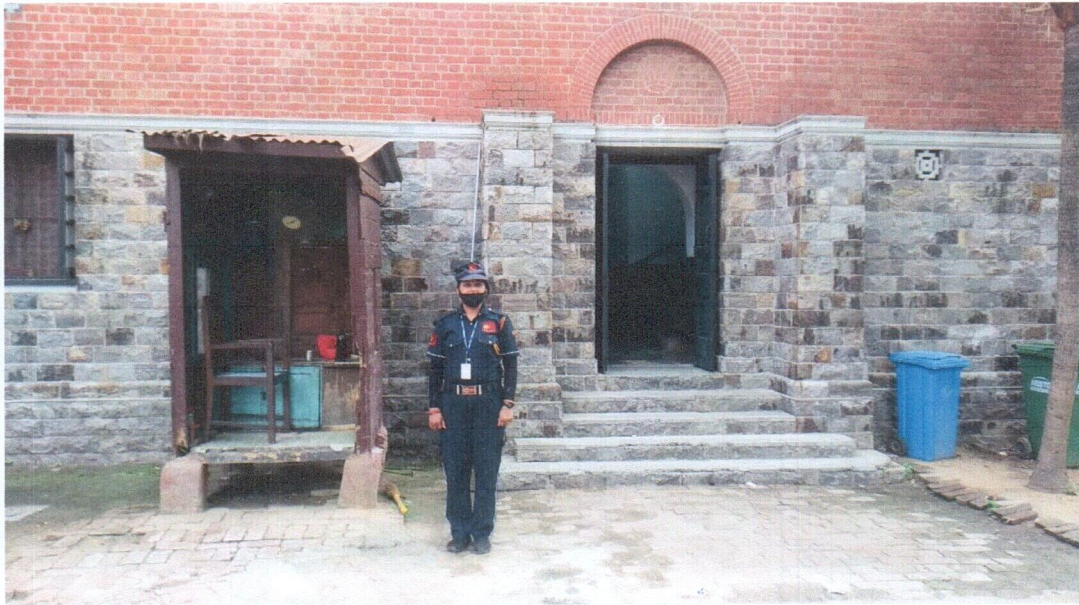






3. Female Guard in front of Rudra South block

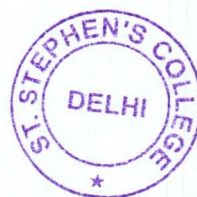
