All the courses under the SGRS are affiliated to the Department of Germanic and Romance Studies, University of Delhi.

The School of Asian Studies (SAS) offers Certificate, Diploma and Advanced Diploma Courses in Chinese Japanese, Sanskrit, Urdu and Persian. Certificate Course in Chinese and Japanese are affiliated to the Department of East Asian Studies, University of Delhi.
