- 2) (B.A. Programme, SEC) LOCF: Understanding Texts, Rituals and Orality in Indian History


He was also the **member of three Syllabus Revision Committees** and revised the following papers:

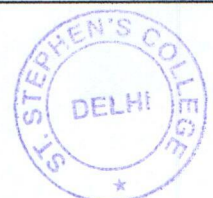
