

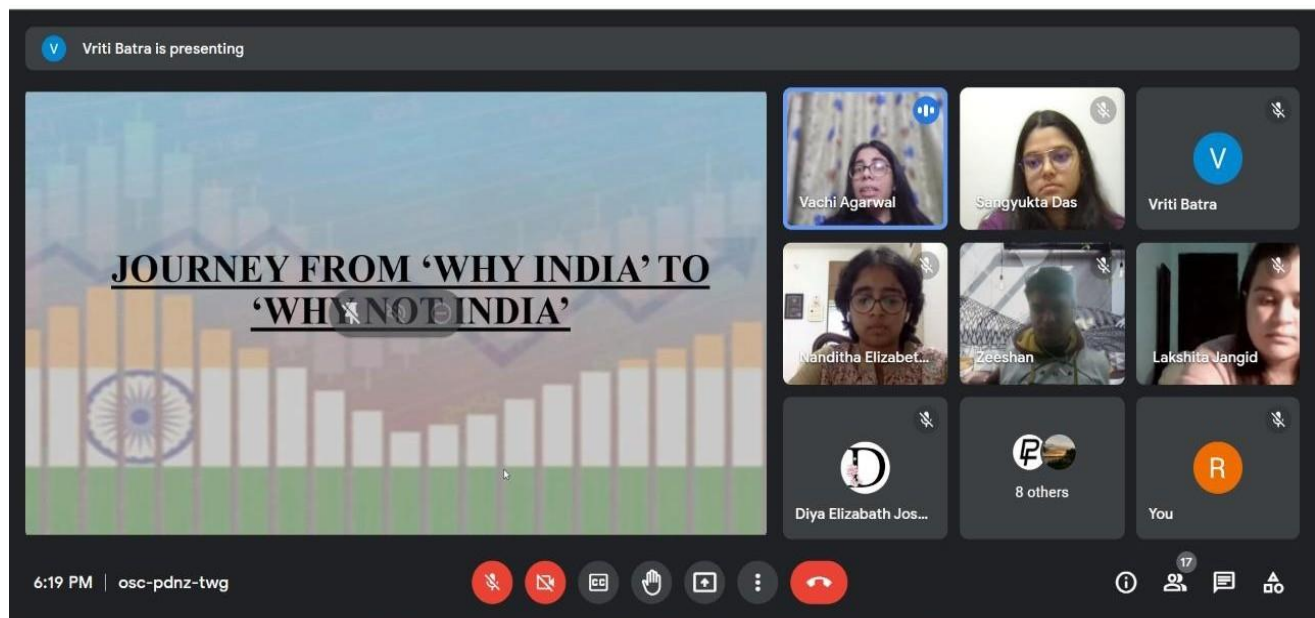
# Academic Article Writing Competition -The Planning Forum

The Planning Forum has successfully conducted an Academic Article Competition as part of Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav initiative. The event was open to those enrolled in undergraduates as well as students from grades 11 and 12. The competition was conducted in two rounds. In the first round, participants were required to send in their abstracts on the theme, 'Analysing India's Growth Trajectory: Looking Back at the Impact of Some Path Breaking Policies', wherein they analysed certain policies in a comprehensive manner, which in their view had impacted India significantly over the past 75 years. The shortlisted teams then qualified for the final round where they presented their articles in front of a panel of judges. The competition had more than 25 participants and we were able to spread the spirit of the Independence movement and the pioneering work the architects of modern India did through the event.

The winner of the competition was Jedidah Asriel from the Tata Institute of Social Sciences. The entry was titled 'Looking Back to Look Ahead', which analysed the telecom policy, the 73rd and 74th amendments of the Indian Constitution, the liberalisation of 1991 and the employment guarantee schemes of the Indian Government.
