The Social Service League resumed one of its major initiatives on campus, the 'Skip A Meal' program on Sunday, 5 September to celebrate *Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav*. The 'Skip A Meal' initiative is a voluntary-based student-led activity where resident junior members voluntarily skip a meal and donate the same to unprivileged areas around Delhi.

The Social Service League got responses from about 60 generous resident junior members from college who skipped a meal which was then collected and packed by the volunteers of the society.

The society had collaborated with the **Robinhood Army**, a volunteer-based Zero funds organization that works to get surplus food and distributes it to the less fortunate sections of the society in cities across India and 14 other countries.

The Robinhood Army conducted the transportation and distribution of food. The distribution took place in **Kashmere Gate** and some other places in its vicinity where the need is utmost.
