Dog Vaccination Drive

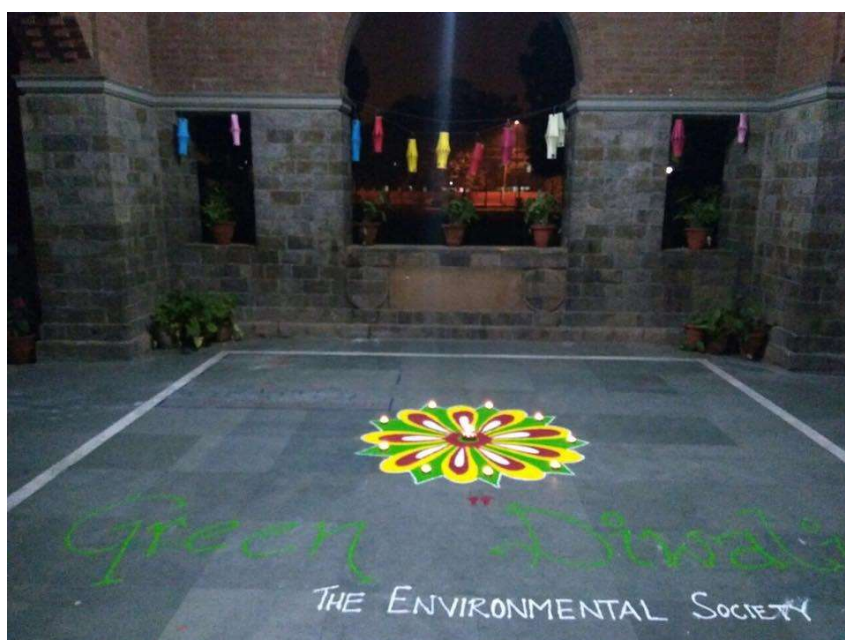
