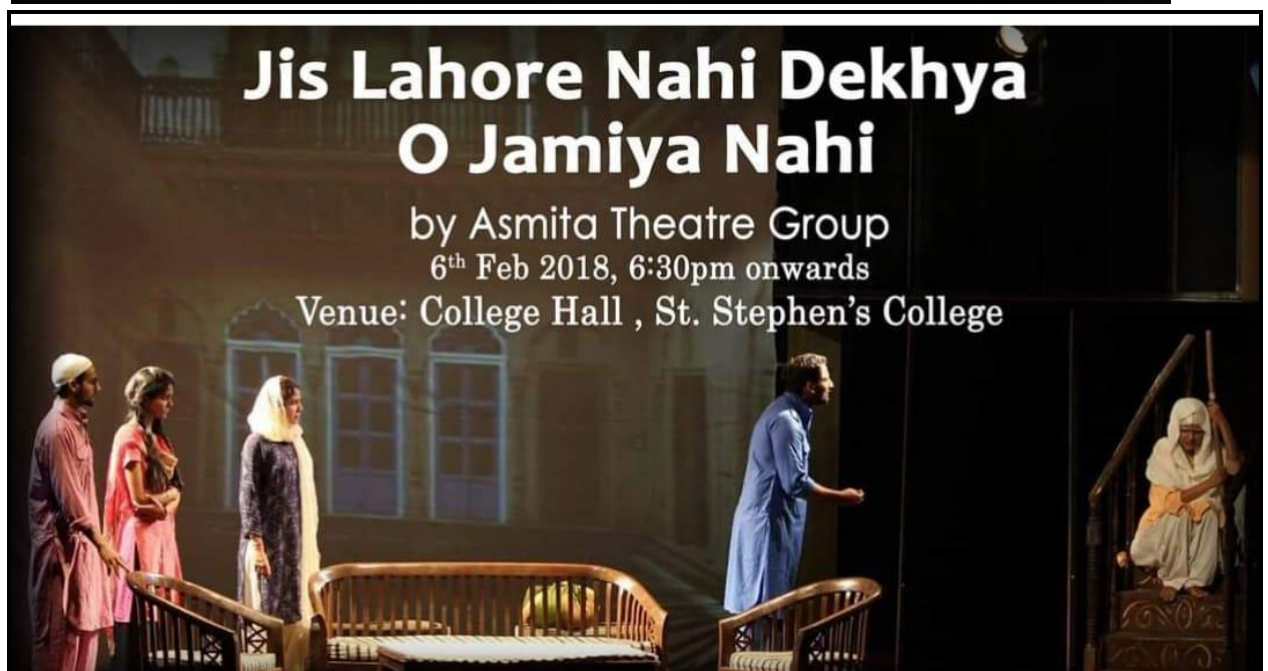
3. Umang'18
