An introductory workshop conducted by members of the Society, aimed to train first year students in basic cube-solving techniques.





22-23 March, 2018: Symposium on Algebra and Its Applications



An event wherein participants use estimation powers in order to solve problems involving heavy calculations.




28 October, 2017: Griphomania







