

Society Activity Report 2017-18

Fine Arts Society

1. FACE PAINTING COMPETITION:

Face Painting Competition was the Fine Arts Society's first event for the academic year 2017- 18. The event took place on 21st August, 2017 at the Café tree. The theme for the competition was 'Juxtapose'. Participants were asked to paint the face of their team member based on the theme provided. The winners of the event were Yuvika Lyall and Ritika Sharon David.



2. **CALLIGRAPHY WORKSHOP:**

A calligraphy workshop was conducted on the 23rd August, 2017 in Room A which was led by Juhi Chitra from the Scratchy Nib. This was a basic calligraphy with brush and ink workshop, at the end of which participants made the final piece under the guidance of the professional typographer.



3. **EXPERIMENTAL LEARNING MODULES:**

A series of workshops and seminars were conducted by The Devi Art Foundation on 29th August, 1st September, 5th & 11th September, 2017. Speakers from The Devi Art Foundation shared insights on different themes for each workshop which basically focussed on hosting and discussing cultural practices within current educational landscapes.



4. A MODERNIST POETRY WORKSHOP:

The Fine Arts Society in collaboration with the Poetry Society conducted an interactive workshop on Modernist Poetry. The speaker for the same was Dr. Natasha Vasisth. It was a good session as many students of the college took part in it. The event was held on 21st September, 2017.



5. **COMMUNITY ART:**

Community Art was hosted on 23rd October, 2017 at the Café tree. Each participant was given a drawing which was originally a part of a bigger artwork. Participants had the liberty to paint that part of the picture as per their own creativity and imagination. All these artworks were then assembled into a common bigger picture which reflected a beautiful integration of different perspectives coming together as a 'community.' An exhibition of all artworks was put on later.



6. **POTTERY WORKSHOP:**

A pottery workshop was conducted on 2nd November, 2017 at Mess Lawns. The workshop was led by a skilled potter, (**potter's name**). Participants of workshop were given a hands-on experience on making clay pots, *diyas* and vases.



7. **MARBLING WORKSHOP:**

The Marbling Workshop was conducted on 18th January, 2018 at the Café tree. Under this, a simplified version of marbling was demonstrated using basic art techniques and materials. Participants used these techniques to craft creative designs on paper.



8. **ARTIPELAGO 2018:**

The society's annual fest, Artipelago took place from 13th to 15th March, 2018. The theme for this year's fest was 'Traditional Art Forms of India'. A series of events were hosted under Artipelago which revolved around the theme:

2. Pot Painting Competition
3. Fusion Art Competition
4. Manner for Nothing Matisse for Free
5. Block Printing Workshop
6. Art Exhibition

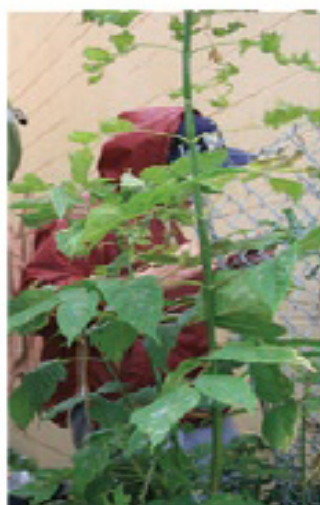

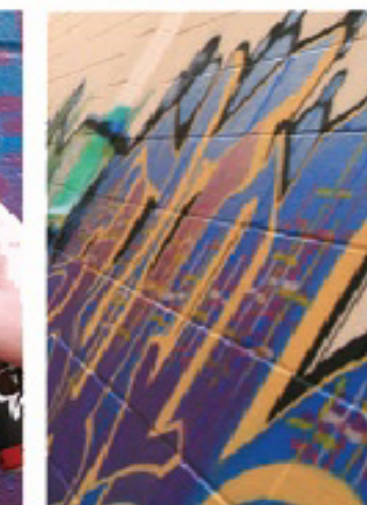
Graffiti on tin
