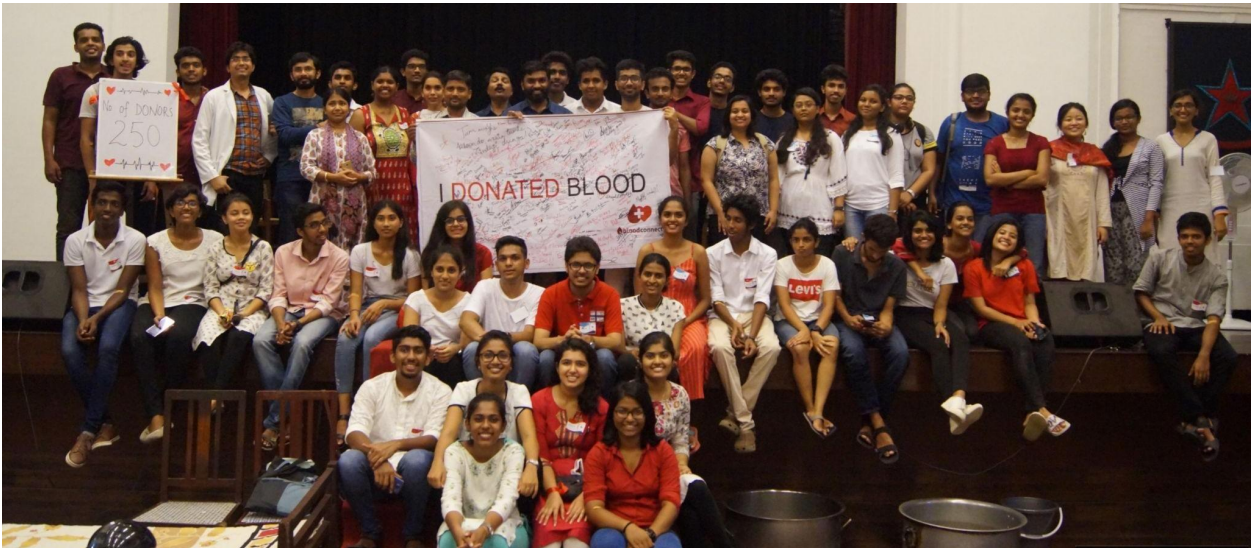




Society Activity Report 2018-19 Social Service League

- **Blood Donation Camp**

It was organized on **24th August** in the College Hall. It was done in collaboration with the *AIIMS, Delhi*. Around 250 blood donors had successfully donated their blood to save the lives of people.





- **Collection Drive**

A collection drive was organized in collaboration with the *Malayalam and the Environmental Society* under the **Kerala Flood Relief** for one week, from **27 August to 1 September** near Cafe Tree at 1pm and 4pm respectively. Materials were collected from students and staff of the college and given to the collection centre at Delhi, which was later shifted to Kerala to aid the flood affected state.

It was held by Vidyajyoti on **15th September** in the rudra lawns to make the kids realize the importance of equality in our daily lives.





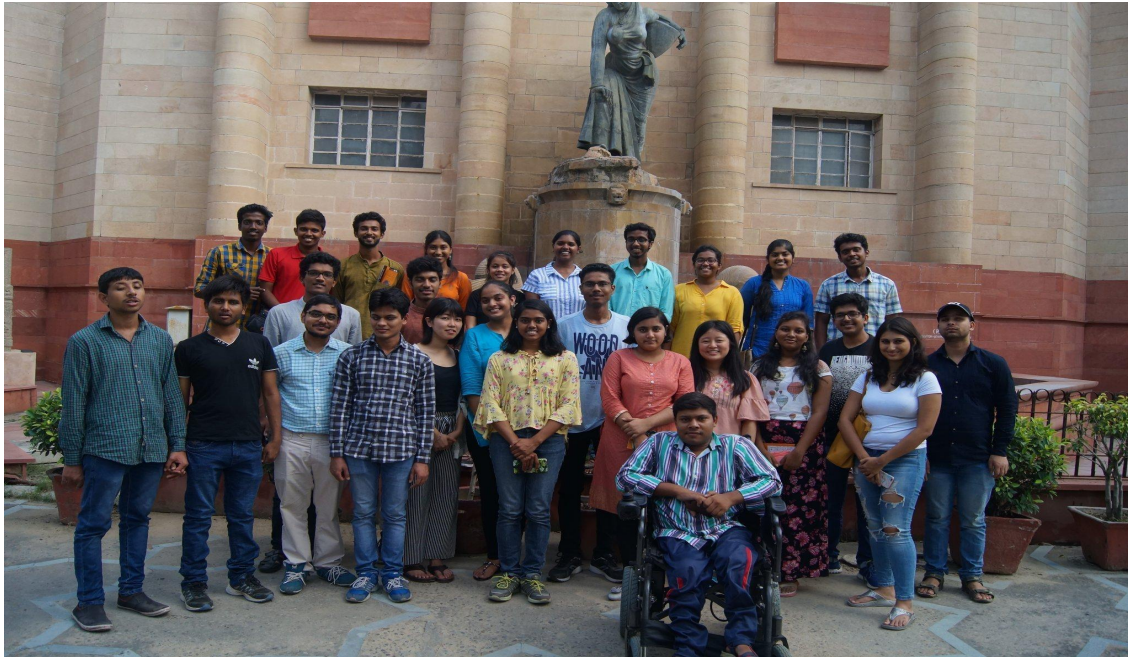
- **Theater Workshop**

It was a keynote lecture for **Vox Populi** and the Guest speaker was *Shri Bezwada Wilson*. He is an Indian activist, who was awarded the Ramon Magsaysay award in 2016. He is the co-founder and National Convenor of the Safai Karmachari Andolan (SKA), an organization that has been campaigning for the eradication of manual scavenging, the construction, operation and employment of manual scavengers which has been illegal in India since 1993. He has been recognised as a Senior Fellow by the Ashoka Foundation for the same.
