PHOTO WALKS AND BASICS OF DSLR WORKSHOP

Over the academic year, the society organised photo walks to places like Safdarjung Tomb and others around Delhi. The main aim behind the Photo Walks is to interact with the society members, to learn the basics of a DSLR and to get accustomed to clicking photographs in foreign spaces. A Basic DSLR workshop was conducted, where the participants got a platform to learn the technical aspects of using a DSLR.

BREAKING FRAMES

Another important event of the odd semester was Breaking Frames which was conducted on 23rd and 24th October 2018. It comprised OF inter-college online photography competitions like 'Main Exhibition' and 'Phone Photography' which were further exhibited in college premises. Intra-college events like 'Photo Projects', 'Technical Exhibition' and 'Treasure Hunt' also witnessed immense participation from college students. A Photo Talk by Vivek Singh, a photojournalist, was also organised as a part of Breaking Frames. Few of the senior society members also conducted a workshop on "The composition of a photograph".

'Main Exhibition', 'Phone Photography' were the inter-college online competitions which were further exhibited in college. An inter-college on the spot photography competition was held with 30+ participants from other Delhi colleges. Inter-college events comprised of the 'Photo Projects', 'Technical Exhibition', 'Film Screening', 'Treasure Hunt' and 'Post Card'. A Photo Talk was presented by Mr Abhishek Hajela, a travel and wildlife photographer, who blessed us with a great time through interacting with fellow society members and also by discussing his work and experiences.

COLLABORATIONS

The society also had a collaboration with The Choreographic Society, St.Stephen's College in organizing a photography competition on the theme: '7 Deadly Sins', the entries were further judged by the members of the society through voting.

EVENT COVERING

In addition to these events, the society members also worked to give photo coverage for all the important events of other societies in the college.

PHOTO OF THE MONTH

'The Photo Of The Month' is a monthly competition wherein entries were invited from the society members based on the theme given at the beginning of every month. The entries were further voted upon and the winner was declared by the end of the month. We also continued our initiative named 'Comments and Critique' wherein the members post their photograph which then is further examined by other members of the society and this helps the individual in improving his/her photography skills.
