### **Inauguration of Waste Disposal Bins**

The pilot project for Waste Management was started by installing new bins, with the aid of the Rotary Club of Delhi Megapolis in October 2018. This later grew into a full-fledged attempt on the part of Environmental Society, as well as the College, to start with waste segregation in a phased manner, beginning with the Residence blocks. The installation of separate bins for plastic waste, paper waste, and everything else has been initiated in the required number in each residence block and the waste is recycled appropriately.





### **Green Diwali Campaign**

Around 15 students from college visited a refugee camp for kids and interacted with over 60 children via different activities and fun sessions aimed towards making them more environmentally conscious and also towards ill effects of bursting crackers. The Society also ran a green diwali campaign, via posters, videos and other means online and on campus. Over 50 students participated in the on campus activities. The activities undertaken were directly aimed at celebrating a greener Diwali without crackers in line with government policy to reduce air and noise pollution during Diwali. This was held in collaboration with the organization Youth for Peace.
