

The Society organised an interesting talk/seminar about how our actions affect the environment. This was held in collaboration with the NGO Youth Alliance.







<u>Inauguration of Waste Disposal Bins</u>

The pilot project for Waste Management was started by installing new bins, with the aid of the Rotary Club of Delhi Megapolis in October 2018. This later grew into a full-fledged attempt on the part of Environmental Society, as well as the College, to start with waste segregation in a phased manner, beginning with the Residence blocks. The installation of separate bins for plastic waste, paper waste, and everything else has been initiated in the required number in each residence block and the waste is recycled appropriately.
