



## **SOCIETY ACTIVITY REPORT 2019-20 CAMPUS PLACEMENT CELL**

The Campus Placement Cell of St. Stephen's College shoulders the responsibility of ensuring that the students of this esteemed institution get the opportunity to obtain work experience in diverse fields after graduation.

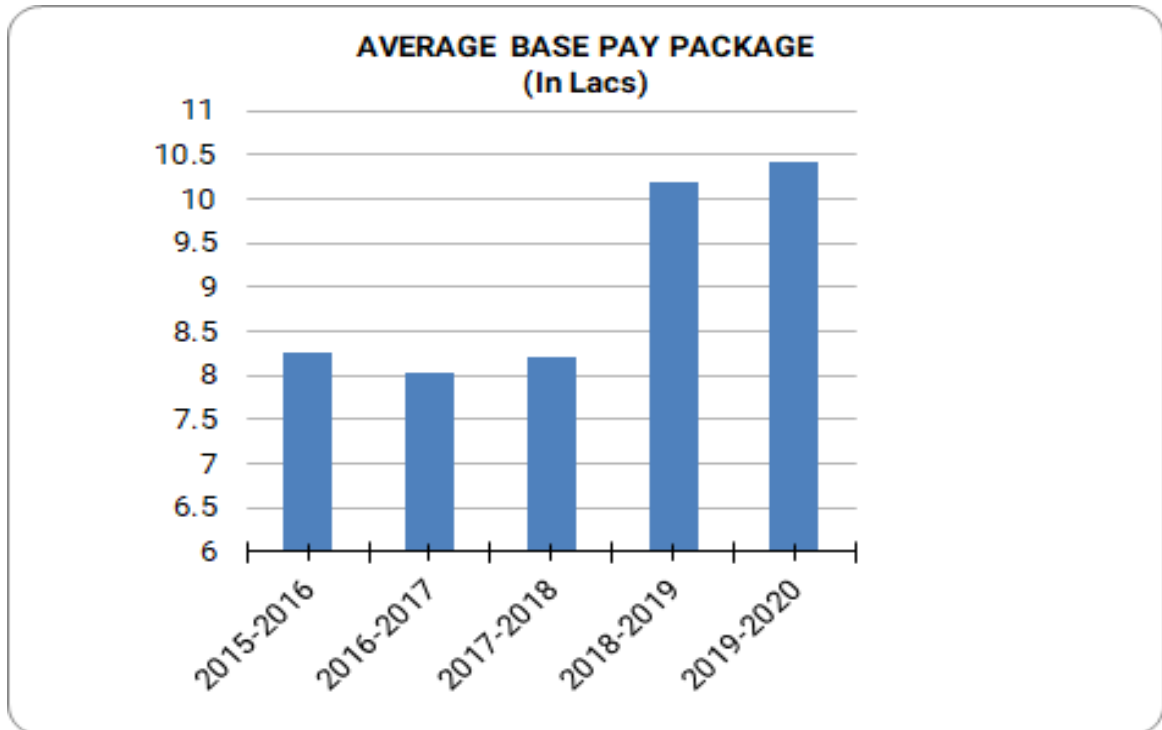
The placement season of 2019-20 has been extremely successful with 61 companies showing interest in recruiting students. This placement season, companies extended 80 offers to students, which is the all-time highest in the history of the college.

Global firms such as Morgan Stanley, Kepler Cannon, Nomura, and CitiBank have recruited our students. Firms like Genpact, Marico, Accenture were among the first time recruiters.

World's top consulting firms such as Mckinsey & Company, Bain & Company, A.T Kearney, EY-Parthenon, LEK Consulting have extended 11 offers this year, compared to 9 offers last year. Top financial institutions such as Morgan Stanley, Nomura, Deutsche Bank, American Express and CitiBank have extended 8 offers this year, compared to 1 offer last year.

The average package offered this year is 10.43 LPA as compared to 10.17 LPA last year, and the procedure of some companies is still going on, hence the average package is likely to increase.

The Internship Fair 2020 also has been extremely successful with over 30 companies extending over 110 offers to the junior members. Top firms such as Salesforce, Berkely Research Group, Tommy Hilfiger India and Maroon Insights hired interns for the first time. 59 companies extended 57 offers this year, compared to 49 companies extending 38 offers last year.



We have also started circulating work from home Internships from February, this year. The attempt was extremely successful with 19 companies extending 53 offers in less than 2 months. We have also established a remote work policy to regulate the remote internship procedures in light of COVID-19 outbreak.

Apart from Placements and Internships, this year we have focused more on higher education opportunities through sessions by the London School of Economics and Political Science, Indian School of Business, Young India Fellowship (Ashoka University) and the University of Massachusetts.

Apart from the recruitment process, we additionally have a Consulting Club under the Campus Placement Cell. As part of the consulting club, we have organized an Internship session, Resume Building workshop, GMAT and CAT sessions and 8 placement preparation sessions to train students for career opportunities in advance.

Continuing the tradition, CPC put forward a large number of opportunities for both placements and internships, bridging the hard work and ambitions of our students with their goals of gaining valuable work experience. The society hopes to be able to do the same in the future as well.
