

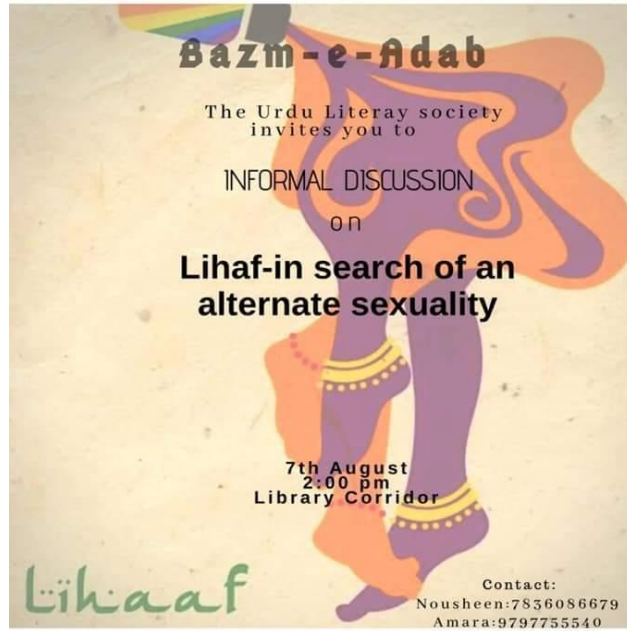


**SOCIETY ACTIVITY REPORT 2019-20**

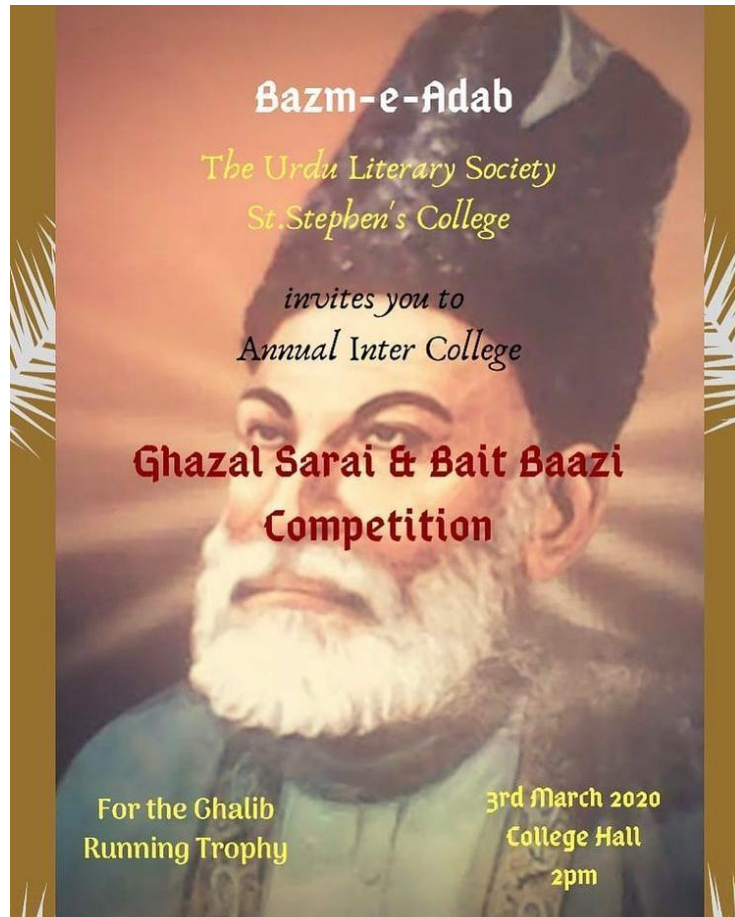






- **College level competition** “Annual Bait Baazi & Ghazal Sarai Competition” was held on 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2020.
