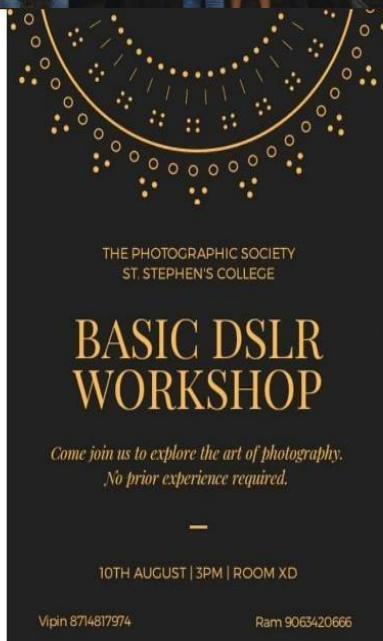
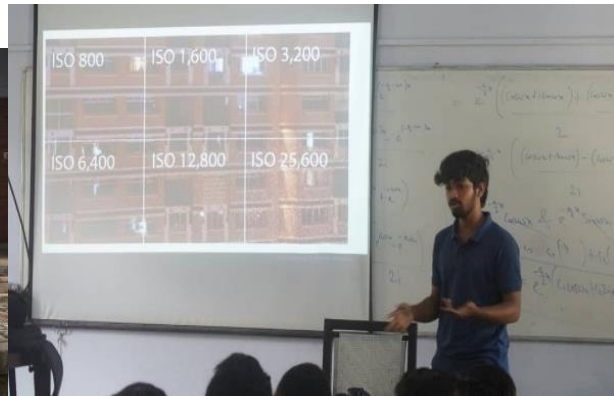
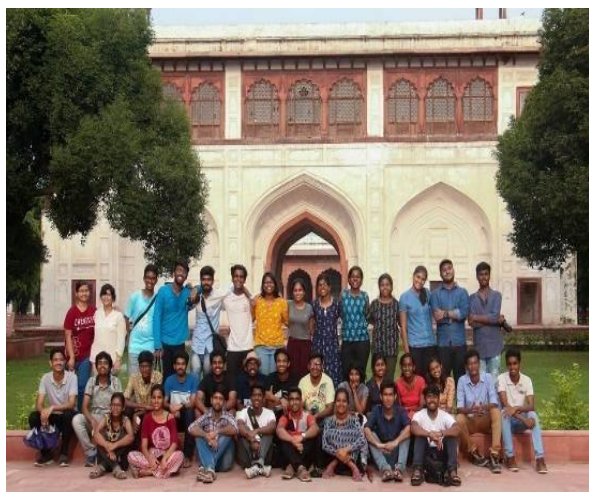




PHOTO WALKS

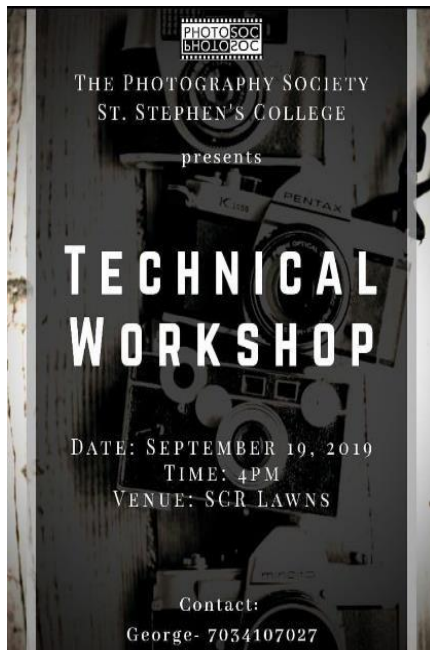

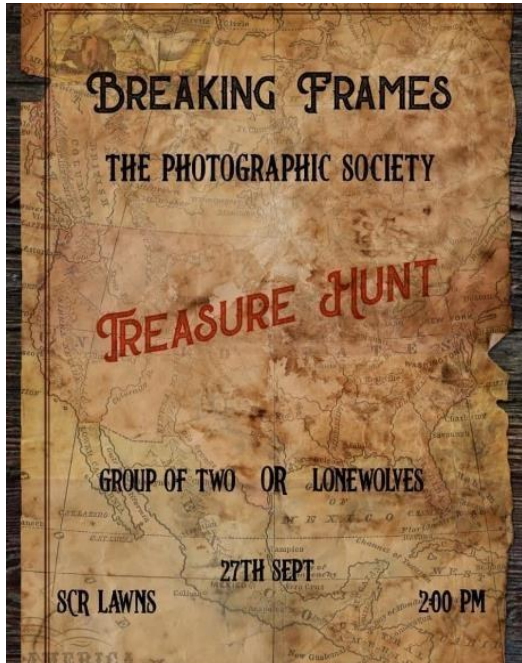
A photography workshop conducted by Canon India on 11th September 2019.

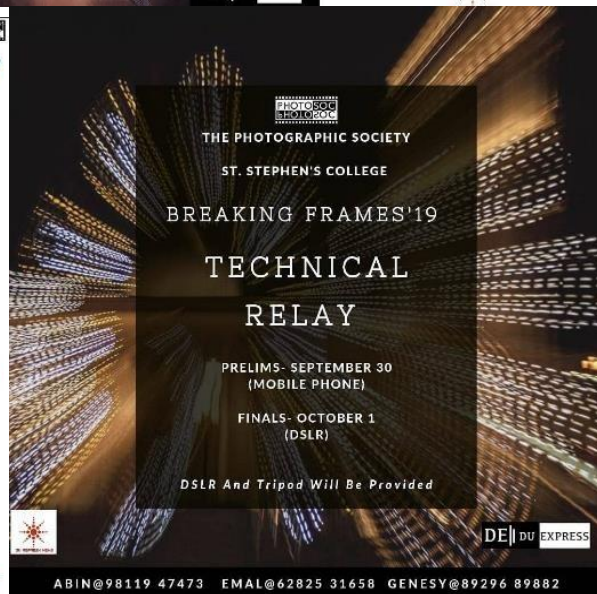
