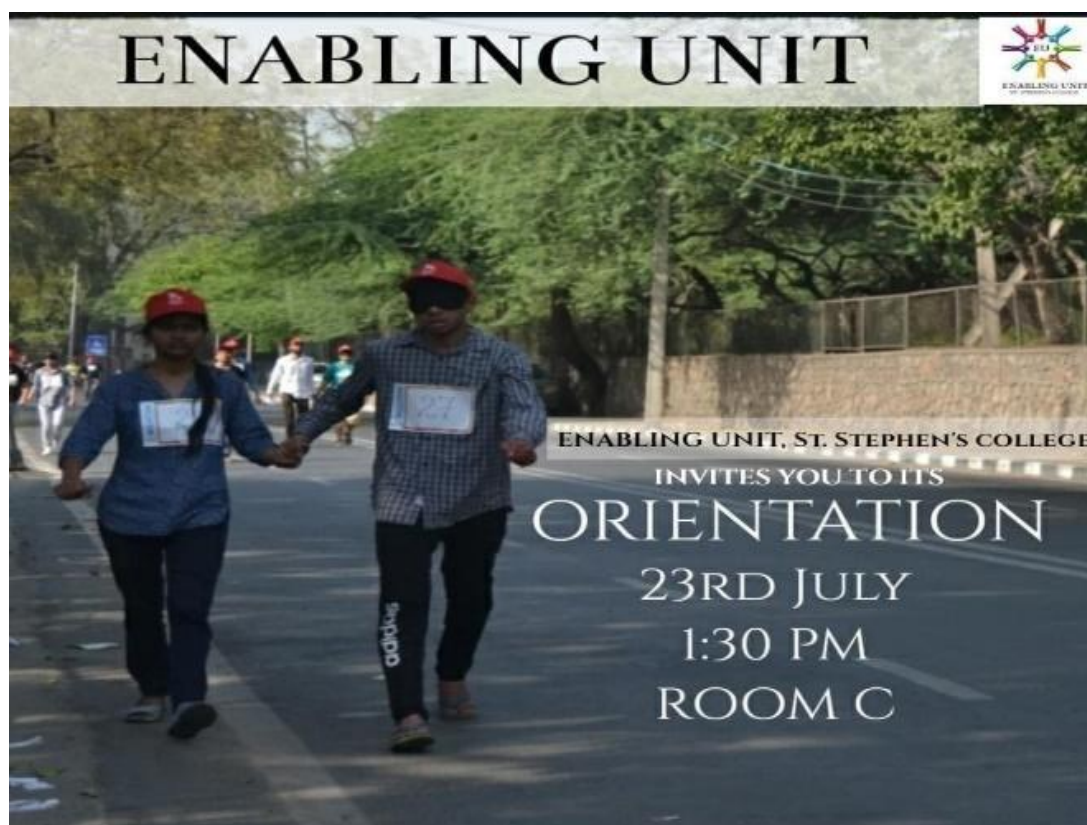




SOCIETY ACTIVITY REPORT 2019-20
