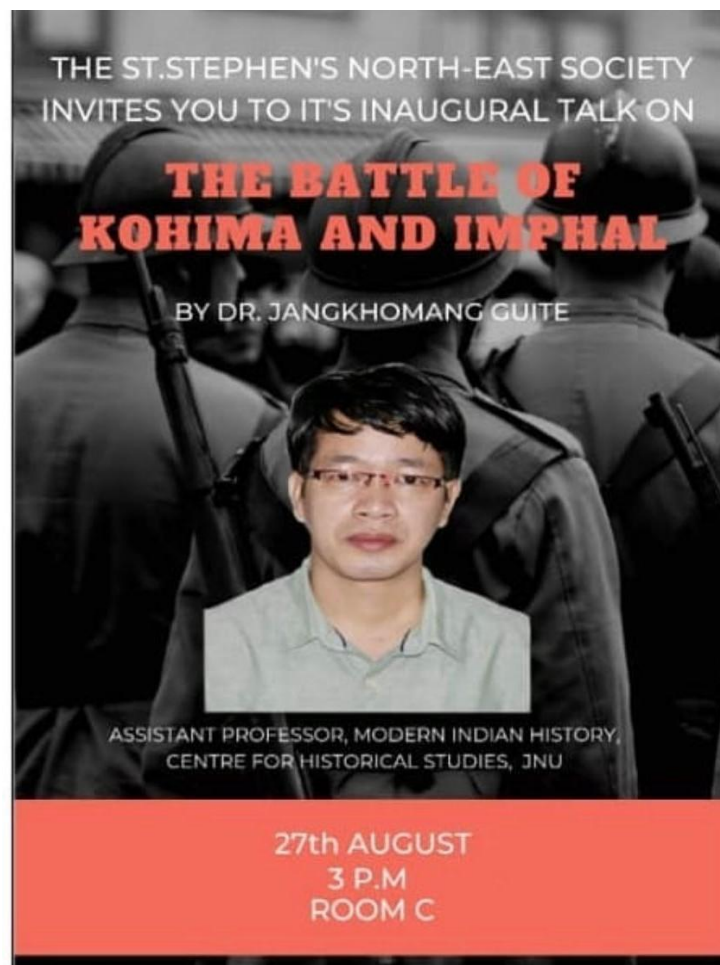


Society Activity Report 2019-20
