Young Leaders Plastic Challenge

This event was a collaboration with UN-India and WWF India to bring about awareness about the problems associated with single use plastic. As part of the event the participants had to undertake activities such as poster making, presentations and attend talk and discussions. The event was divided into various levels and e-certificates of participation were issued to the participants by WWF-India. Almost 90 students took part in the event.

Green Diwali Campaign

This was a campaign to promote eco-friendly ways to celebrate diwali. The society undertook various activities as part of the campaign including interview in Connaught Place, video on Connaught Place interview, poster making session in campus, visit to children in GTB Nagar, to spread awareness on green diwali and to distribute gifts and sweets.





Chintan Workshop

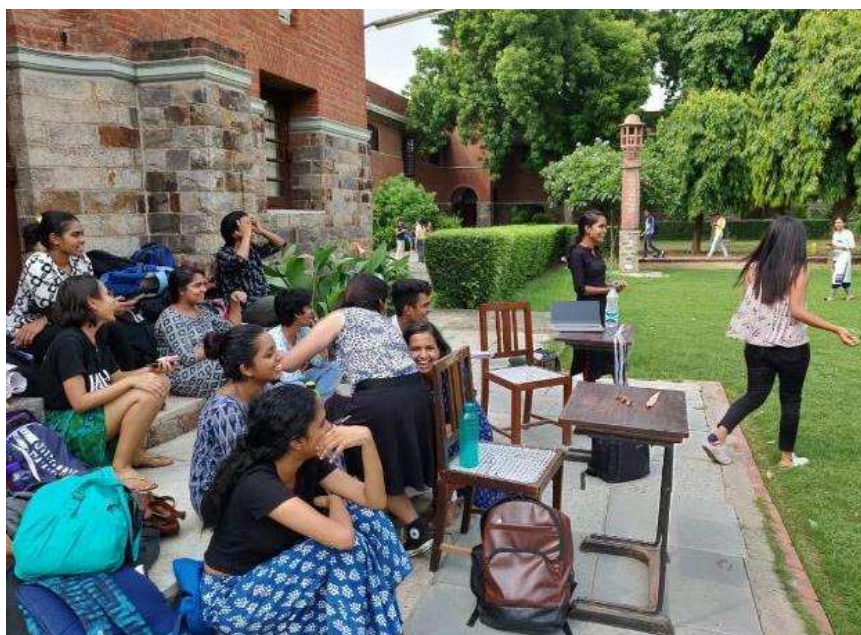
This was a workshop conducted along with an NGO Chintan on the harmful effects of single use plastic in the country. The workshop was attended by almost 50 students.

The event had an online and offline campaign. The on campus event included Turning off electricity on campus from 8:30pm-9:30pm ,decorating mess lawns and diyas were light, music and photography events were also held along with the event.

As part of the online campaign we went live from 8:30pm-9:30pm on Instagram ,connected to the event on campus along with online games to bring about consciousness about the environment.





Waste Management

Separate bins were installed in each block for segregating the waste into dry paper(Yellow),Plastic(Blue)and miscellaneous(Green). Karamcharis were sensitised and educated with regard to the waste collection. 2-3 volunteers were selected from each block to monitor the functioning of the system and to report problems faced by karamcharis and students. The project is still a work in progress and we expect the system to be completely established and functional in another year's time.



Talk on Climate crisis and Activism

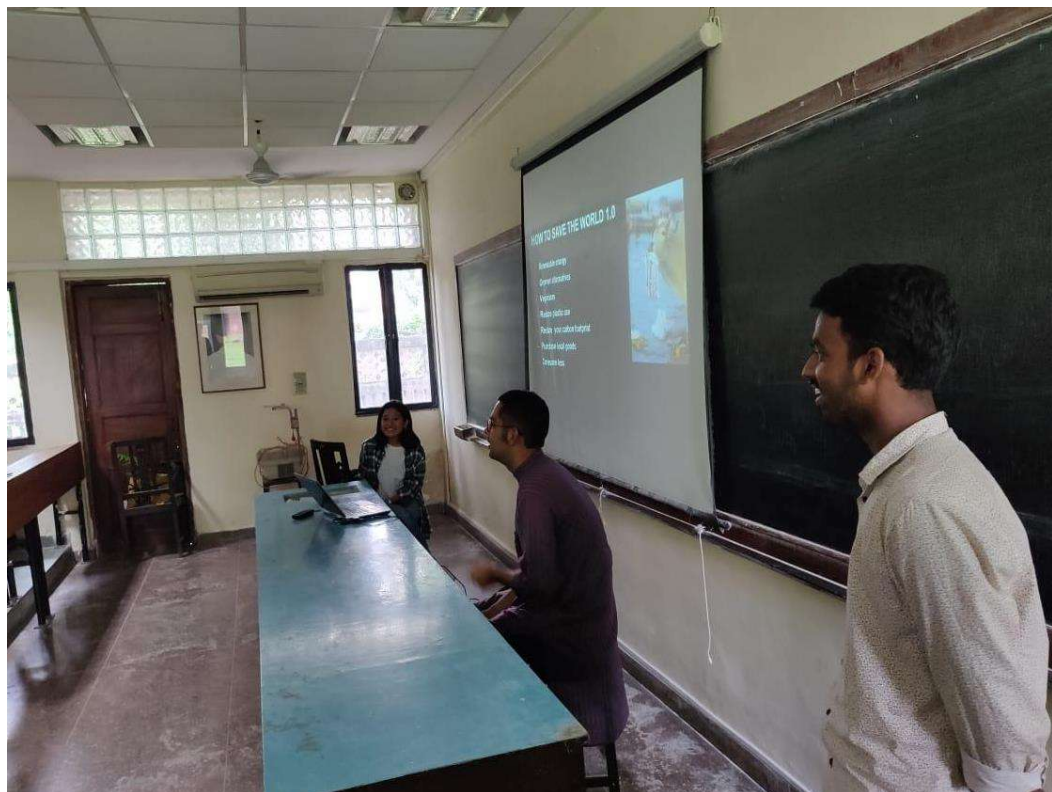
A talk was organised in collaboration with the Delhi wing of Fridays for Future to promote observance of fundamental duty to protect and improve the natural environment.
