



SOCIETY ACTIVITY REPORT 2020-21 CAMPUS PLACEMENT CELL

The Campus Placement Cell of St. Stephen's College shoulders the responsibility of ensuring that the students of this esteemed institution get the opportunity to obtain work experience in diverse fields after graduation.

The placement season of 2020-21 has been quite successful and above our expectations with over **43** firms showing interest in recruiting students. This placement season, **27** companies extended a total of **59 offers** to the students. The Cell was quick enough to adapt to the virtual model of recruitment this year. We ensured both the companies and the students were comfortable with virtual placements this academic year.

World's top consulting firms such as Mckinsey & Company, Bain & Company, Accenture have extended 7 offers this year. Top financial institutions such as Morgan Stanley, D.E Shaw, Nomura, and ICICI Bank have extended 13 offers this year, compared to 8 offers last year.

The average base pay package offered this year is **7.34 LPA** and the average CTC offered this year is **8.72 LPA**. The procedure of some companies is still going on, and hence the average pay package is likely to increase.

The Internship Conclave 2020-21 previously known as Internship Fair has also been extremely successful, with over **63** companies extending over **212 offers** to the junior members. Top firms such as Deutsche Bank, RSA Actuarial Services, JSW, and Salesforce hired interns. We also saw Hindustan Unilever coming on campus for the first time to hire interns and have extended 2 offers.

We circulated both remote as well as summer internships. We came up with a policy for the students to regulate internship procedures in light of the COVID-19 outbreak.

Apart from Placements and Internships, this year we have also focused on higher education opportunities through Young India Fellowship (Ashoka University), Masters in Public Policy (Kautilya School of Public Policy)

We additionally have Consulting Club, a vertical under the Campus Placement Cell. As a part of the Consulting Club, we organized a series for University Admissions where alumni who are currently pursuing Masters from universities like Cambridge and



Oxford helped students make well-informed decisions for their future. Separate sessions were held for both the Arts and Science streams.

Sessions on various competitive examinations like IIT JAM and CAT were also conducted. We were also approached by Northeastern University and London Business School for an informative webinar about their curriculums respectively. Additionally, we have organized an Internship session, CV Building workshop, and 7 placement preparation sessions to train students for career opportunities in advance.

CPC, as in the past, strives to provide as many opportunities for both placements and internships, bridging the hard work and ambitions of our students with their goals of gaining valuable work experience. We try to ensure that students have a variety of options to choose from while making crucial decisions for their future. We hope to continue with this endeavour in the following year as well.
