It was a series of interactive sessions by eminent personalities that included Dr. Subramanian Swamy (Member of Parliament), Mr. Kapil Dev (Cricketer), Mr. Amarjit Singh Batra (CEO, OLX), N. Bhanu Prakash (The Fastest Human Calculator) and Dr. Manoj Choudhary (Entreprenuer).



The Conference started with the interactive session by Dr. Sumbramanian Swamy, the college hall filled with enthusiastic students from all over the Delhi University. Speaking on "Unending Ambiguity- State of Indian Economy", Dr. Swamy spoke with great charisma and left the audience beaming with joy. He also answered some of the queries from the audience and enlightened us all with significant knowledge.

Mr. Kapil Dev, the name synonymous with Indian cricket, was our next keynote speaker for the conference. The charismatic, aggressive and headstrong Kapil Dev, speaking about "My Journey - Through the evolving world of Cricket" talked about how he started his career in a sport, which most Indians would consider as a religion, Cricket. He took out most of his time on the stage to interact with the students and answering their queries.
