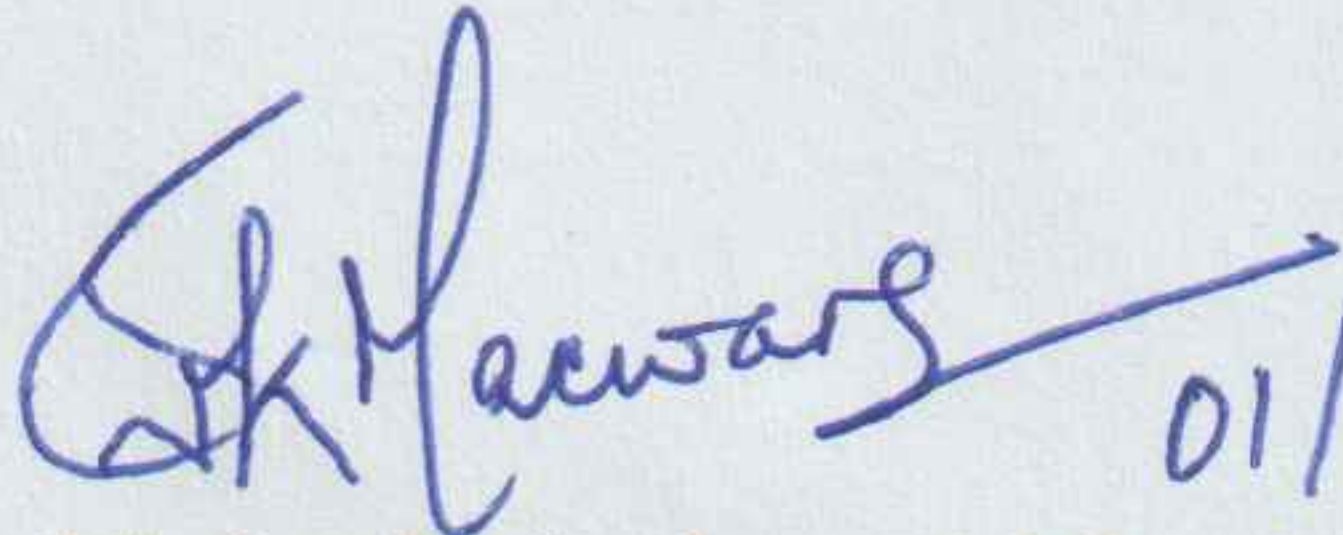

Code of Conduct for Candidates contesting ICC Elections

- Junior members of any course are allowed to contest in ICC Student representative elections. Due to requirements regarding the composition of the ICC, there **must be at least two female representatives**.
- **Campaigning for ICC elections will not be allowed after the OPEN COURT for SUS Elections scheduled on 09th September 2026.** Candidates are directed to only campaign during the allotted time. Non-compliance may result in disqualification of the candidature.
- No means other than personally talking to fellow students or addressing classrooms with prior permission of senior faculty members will be allowed as publicity. Specifically, no online publicity through messages in groups or offline publicity in the form of printed materials is allowed.
- All candidates must conduct themselves with integrity and respect toward fellow candidates, students, and faculty. Harassment, intimidation, or discrimination in any form will not be tolerated.
- Candidates should provide truthful information about their qualifications, goals, and intentions. Any form of misinformation or deceit is strictly prohibited.
- All candidates must commit to a non-discriminatory approach in their campaigns, respecting individuals regardless of gender, sexual orientation, race, ethnicity, religion, or disability.
- During the open court, candidates must refrain from negative campaigning or personal attacks against opponents. Focus should remain on suitability, goals, and the issues at hand.
- Campaigning, after the SUS open court on 09 September 2026, or any form of intimidation during the voting process will result in immediate disqualification of the candidates.
