Open Book Examination (OBE) Guidelines for Certificate, Diploma and
Advanced Diploma Examinations

Due to present scenario under the threat of pandemic Covid-19, University of Delhi has issued different Notifications for conducting examinations for different examinations for academic session 2019-20 under Open Book Examination (OBE) as an alternative mode of examination as a one-time measure to facilitate the students for further higher studies or to join any career endeavour further in the stipulated time as decided by the task force and adopted by the working group on examinations.

Students of Certificate/Diploma/Advanced Diploma are required to adhere to the following guidelines during the examination:

- Students should check the date-sheet of Certificate, Diploma and Advanced Diploma Examinations on the University website: <http://du.ac.in/> WhatsApp groups and be prepared for the examination as per the following:
- Switch on your mobile data/Wi-Fi half an hour before the start of the examination.
- All candidates have to write the answers as per questions sent for the respective paper on the **plain sheet (A4)** and the following details will be written on the first page of the answer sheet:
Date of Examination: Roll No.
Name of the candidate: Father's Name:
Course: Paper No.
Subject: Title of the paper: Candidate's Signature:
- The question paper for the examinations will be emailed to the email ids provided by the students and will also be sent on the WhatsApp group created for the purpose at **(9.00 AM.)**
- The total duration of the OBE shall be of 3 hours (09.00 am-12.00 Noon) of which **TWO hours** shall be given to the students for answering the questions and an **additional hour** shall be utilized for downloading the question papers and uploading the scanned images of answer sheets after completion of the examinations.
- The students belonging to the Divyaang (PWD) Category shall be given additional time and other facilities as the rules applicable in the University of Delhi.
- The scanned written answer sheets will be sent back to departmentofarabic@gmail.com within the provided time limit (**12 Noon**).

St. Stephen College, University of Delhi.
